The Board of the Directors is recommending a change to the Club dues for the Rule of 85 members and the members on Leaves of Absence. According to some members, this is not so much a change, as it is going back to a past practice. It is recommended that Rule of 85 members (age + years in Rotary is equal to or greater than 85) be assessed a fee of \$40 per quarter. This assessment will cover the hard costs associated with the membership, including District and International dues, as well as cover some of the Club operational costs. The same assessment is billed to members who are on Leaves of Absence. In both cases, the Club incurs these costs, and they should be passed on to the member. This recommendation has been developed by the Membership Committee and has the unanimous support of the Board. There will a vote of the general membership at the Club meeting on March 16 held at Old Ranch Country Club.
